**FUNERALS:** At a Deanery Meeting held last week, it was decided to make better provision for funerals that occur when the resident priest is away, unwell, or otherwise unavailable. The present arrangement is that the Navan clergy cover such funerals in neighbouring parishes. This is unsustainable given the heavy workload already borne by the priests at St Marys and the significant number of funerals every week in Navan itself.

Our parish will from now on be paired with Oristown parish for the purposes of funerals. This means that in the absence of the parish priest of Bohermeen, Fr. John O'Brien will be available for funerals, and in his absence the parish priest of Bohermeen will cover Oristown. Bereaved families will be invited to call on the respective priest at his Parochial House to make all necessary funeral arrangements. The parish secretaries and sacristans, and funeral directors will be essential to the smooth operation of this new pastoral provision.
