Tip of the week – stay in contact with your family and friends

You can talk, see and stay in contact with your family and friends by signing up for Zoom. It's free !
If you are not already doing this then go on to your PC, laptop, tablet or smart phone and follow these set up instructions.

Place your cursor over <https://zoom.us/signup> and click.

It takes you to the Zoom website “sign up free”.
Enter your email address.

Zoom will send you an email to confirm your request. Simply click on the connection in the email. It will take you directly to the Zoom start page.

Ask your family member or friend to follow the same procedure.

To start a video meeting

Agree by phone or text what time you are going to video meet up.

Whoever is organising the meeting, go to “host a meeting” at the top of the Zoom screen.

In the drop-down menu, click on “with video on”

A prompt will show “host Zoom meeting”, click on it.

In a minute, the device camera will show you live on screen.

At the bottom of the screen click on “invite”

A new screen will invite you to click on “gmail”
Simply enter the email address of your family member or friend.

For your family member or friend to join the meeting

Look out for an incoming email at the agreed meeting time.

Simply place your cursor over the blue Zoom link, press “ctrl” key on keyboard and then click

POPE FRANCIS: "I know that many of you go to confession before Easter...Many will say to me: 'But Father... I can't leave the house and I want to make my peace with the Lord. I want Him to embrace me...How can I do that unless I find a priest? Do what the catechism says. It's very clear. If you don't find a priest to go to confession, speak to God. He's your Father. Tell Him the truth: 'Lord, I did this and this and this. Pardon me.' Ask his forgiveness with all your heart with an act of contrition, and promise Him, 'afterward I will go to confession.' You will return to God's grace immediately. You yourself can draw near, as the catechism teaches us, to God's forgiveness without having a priest at hand.'
