# What will happen at the gatherings?

Parish Animators have been trained to lead the gatherings in a reflective, prayerful atmosphere. Questions will be presented on the evening and people will gather in small groups to share on each question and listen to each other.

Each small group will have a leader who will help everyone to have the opportunity to share and will collect the feedback from the group.

When you think of your experience of Church, what brings hope?

How can we, as Catholics, create a real sense of welcome, belonging and inclusion in our parish community?
