# Points to Ponder-Catholic Health Association. The Intercom

Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday were fast days for the disciples. Trauma followed tragedy with no time to process or make sense of what happened. In shock, overcome with grief, the pair are soon joined by a stranger who to their amazement, seems not to know what has transpired. As they walk, the two explain the situation of confusion, torture and loss.

The stranger, who is the risen Jesus unrecognised, tells them the story from a new lens and a larger perspective.

Beginning with the foundations of faith in Moses and the prophets witness, the hidden Christ unpacks all the promises of God to show how they point to the paschal mystery of death and resurrection.

Every day, every moment, we are called to open our eyes to the broader story of grace, accompaniment and love happening all around us.

To make meaning of our experience, we take the long view and see how goodness, hope and love are resurrected again and again in our lives. Resurrection, the joy and hope of Easter, indeed the person of Jesus, can find us anywhere. In the hallways, bedsides and boardrooms and at our home offices or shared workstations. Our celebrations and grief can all be opportunities to stop, look around and see the sacred in our midst.


We must notice and respond when our hearts burn within us and ask:

Where is God accompanying me on my journey?

Who is the hidden Christ in our midst? Where is the resurrection playing out now and always?

# Seeing your Life through the Lens of the Gospel by John Byrne OSA. The Intercom

- 1.Jesus joined the despondent disciples and listened to them. 'We had hoped...' ...... When you have been upset or disappointed, who has joined you along the road? To whom have you been able to pour out your heart?' Who was a 'Jesus person' to you, listening to you in respectful silence? To whom have you been a Jesus person?
- 2. Jesus then helps them to see things in another light by opening the scriptures to them. When did you have the experience of finding your heart 'burning within you' with new hope for the future? Who/what helped you to change after a setback?
- 3. The disciples invite Jesus to join them at table —there follows a recognition of who he is. We meet many people on the road of life. Usually we meet and pass on. Occasionally we meet someone whom we invite into our homes, into our hearts, in a deeper way. In what way in such relationships have you experienced the presence of God or ofJesus7
- 4. After Jesus had gone the disciples went to bring the good news to others. When have you met others who told you what happened to them along their road? What effect did this sharing have on you? When have you done this with others? When was such a conversation 'good news' for you or others?
