Cecil Day Lewis wrote a very poignant poem called *Walking Away*. He recalled the day when his seven-year-old son played his first football match. After the game the boy drifted away to follow his pals. The sensitive eye of the poet saw this as the first indication that his son would develop his selfhood and the parent would have to let him walk away. The last three lines of the poem describe how this first parting was...

Saying what God alone could perfectly show How selfhood begins with a walking away And love is proved in the letting go.

The pattern is repeated in every parent-child relationship: when to hold on, when to let go; when to permit and when to forbid; when to insist and when to back down; when to refuse and when to consent.

Even the apostles had to learn when to let go of the physical presence of Jesus. But it was then that their new selfhood as the Church came to birth in their transformation by the Spirit of Pentecost.


Final DTiM Mass-Sunday 28th May at 11.30am in <mark>Bohermeen</mark>
